Promoted a "Rethink Your Drink" campaign for 5 years to encourage children and parents to choose water over sugary beverages.

Facilitated the donation of 15 mountain bikes from the Bureau of Land Management to the City of Bishop Recreation Department. 4-H provided a bicycle maintenance class to work on the donated bikes and prepare them for use.
